

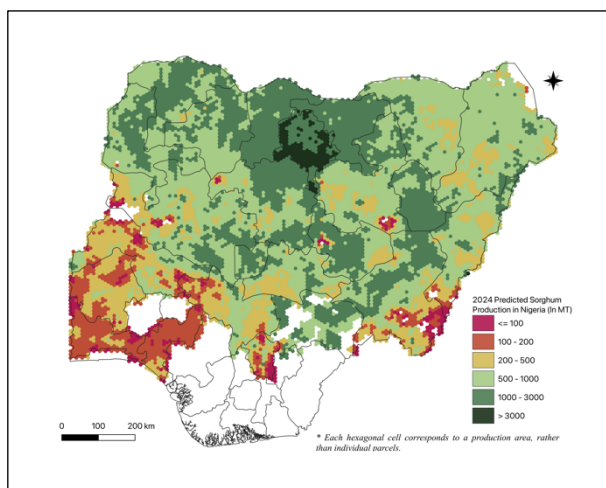
AAGWa Crop Production Forecasts Brief Series Nigeria – Sorghum

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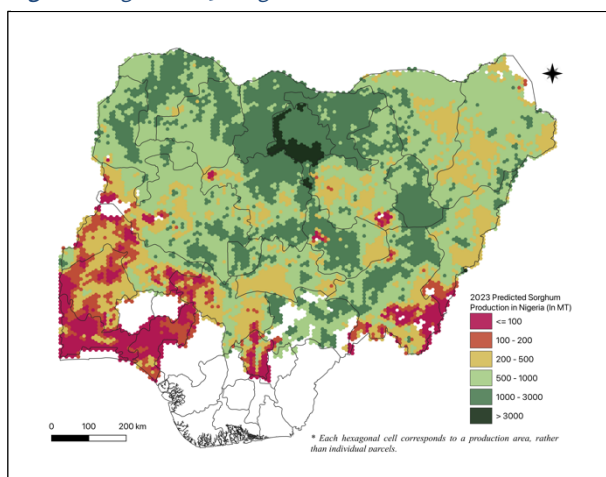
The crop production forecast brief series by AKADEMIYA2063's Africa Agriculture Watch (AAGWa) aims to provide more accurate and timely data on harvest and yields for nine major crops across nearly

50 African countries. The timeliness, wide availability, and easy access to this type of data will allow stakeholders across the value chain to better plan and execute policy and business actions more efficiently. The data published in the briefs are generated through the Africa Crop Production (AfCP) model, an Artificial Intelligence (AI-based) model applied to remotely sensed geo-biophysical data to produce estimates at pixel as well as administrative levels as early as the beginning of every growing season. In Brief 192, we provide forecasts on sorghum production in Nigeria.

In 2024, sorghum production in Nigeria is projected to reach 7,908,387 metric tons (MT), which indicates a 9% increase over 2023 production levels. The most significant production levels are expected in the Eastern and Central parts of the country, particularly in Gassol (Taraba), Karim Lamido (Taraba), Maru (Zamfara), Bali (Taraba), Sumaila (Kano), and Ningi (Bauchi), with production levels estimated at 83,971 MT, 72,269 MT, 70,510 MT, 68,916 MT, 65,447 MT, and 60,172 MT, respectively. In comparison, lower production volumes are observed in cities such as Ifako/Ijaye (Lagos), Ibadan South-West (Oyo), Aiyedade (Osun), Ovia North-East (Edo), Abeokuta South (Ogun), and Umu Nneochi (Abia), with production levels reaching only, 56 MT, 57 MT, 77 MT, 116 MT, 117 MT, and 123 MT, respectively.

Moreover, the most significant sorghum production increases in 2024 are expected to occur in Toro (Bauchi), Baruten (Kwara), Bali, Ningi, Mashegu (Niger), and Maru, with differences reaching 6,849 MT, 6,804 MT,

6,757 MT, 6,319 MT, 6,030 MT, and 5,614 MT. These correspond to changes of 16%, 20%, 11%, 12%, 16%, and 9%.
