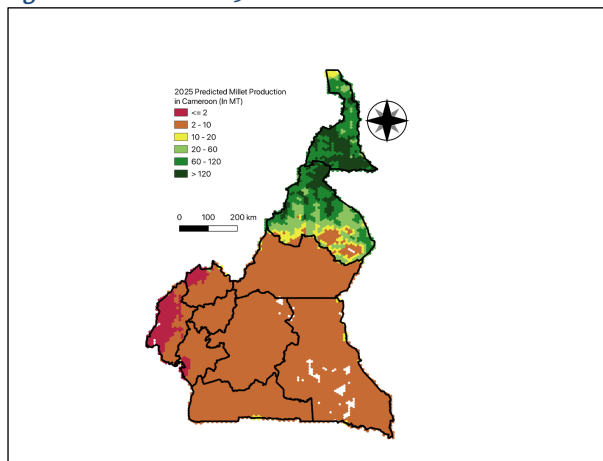
Cameroon – Millet

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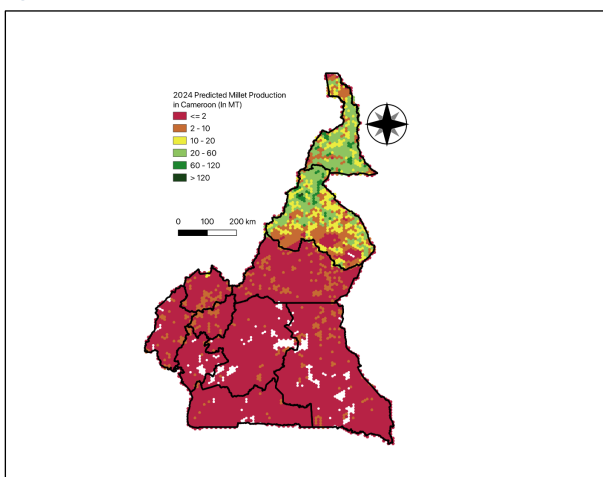
The crop production forecast brief series by AKADEMIYA2063's Africa Agriculture Watch (AAGWa) aims to provide more accurate and timely data on harvest and yields for 11 major crops across nearly 50 African countries. The timeliness, wide availability, and easy access to this type of data will allow stakeholders across the value chain to better plan and execute policy and business actions more efficiently. The data published in the briefs are generated through the Africa Crop Production (AfCP) model, an Artificial Intelligence (AI-based) model applied to remotely sensed geo-biophysical data to produce estimates at pixel as well as administrative levels as early as the beginning of every growing season. In Brief 289, we provide forecasts on millet production in Cameroon.

In 2025, millet production in Cameroon is projected to reach 122,136 metric tons (MT), indicating a 7% increase over 2024 production levels. The highest millet producers are expected to be Mayo Rey (Nord), Bénoué (Nord), Logone et Chari (Extrême-Nord), Mayo Kani (Extrême-Nord), and Diamaré (Extrême-Nord), with production levels estimated at 19,375 MT, 15,987 MT, 11,763 MT, 8,302 MT, and 7,823 MT. In contrast, lower production values are observed in Ndiang (Sud-Ouest), Hauts Plateaux (Ouest), Wouri (Littoral), Koung Khi (Ouest), and Mfoundi (Centre) with production of 30 MT, 30 MT, 27 MT, 24 MT, and 22 MT, respectively.

Compared to 2024, the most significant millet production increases in 2025 are expected in districts such as Logone et Chari (Extrême-Nord), Mayo Rey (Nord), Bénoué (Nord), Haute Sanaga (Centre), and Mayo Danay (Extrême-Nord), with differences of 1,405 MT, 1,166 MT, 843 MT, 578 MT, and 511 MT, respectively. These correspond to changes of 14%, 6%, 6%, 139%, and 7%.
