



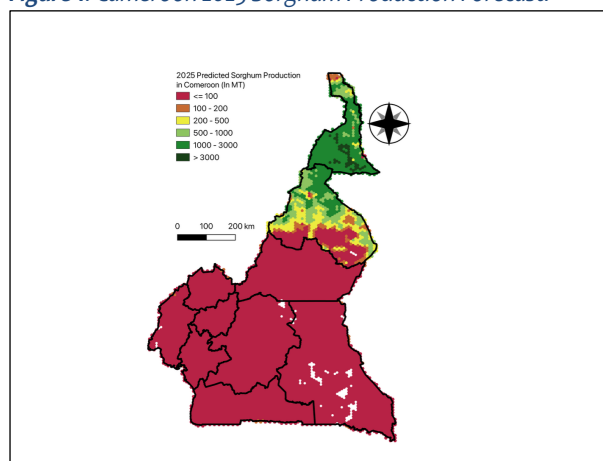
AAGWa Crop Production Forecasts Brief Series Cameroon – Sorghum

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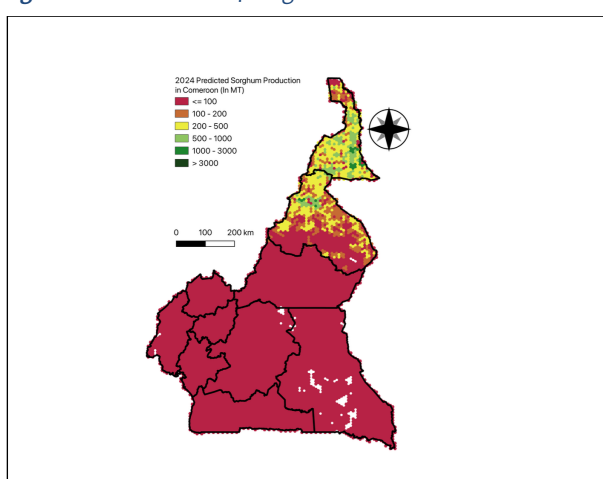
The crop production forecast brief series by AKADEMIYA2063's Africa Agriculture Watch (AAGWa) aims to provide more accurate and timely data on harvest and yields for 11 major crops across nearly 50

differences of 11,339 MT, 10,007 MT, 4,267 MT, 4,210 MT, and 3,316 MT, respectively. These correspond to changes of 9%, 6%, 64%, 3%, and 3%.

African countries. The timeliness, wide availability, and easy access to this type of data will allow stakeholders across the value chain to better plan and execute policy and business actions more efficiently. The data published in the briefs are generated through the Africa Crop Production (AfCP) model, an Artificial Intelligence (AI-based) model applied to remotely sensed geo-biophysical data to produce estimates at pixel as well as administrative levels as early as the beginning of every growing season. In Brief 290, we provide forecasts on sorghum production in Cameroon.

In 2025, sorghum production in Cameroon is projected to reach 1,282,814 metric tons (MT), indicating a 1% increase over 2024 production levels. The highest sorghum producers are expected to be Logone et Chari (Extrême-Nord), Mayo Kani (Extrême-Nord), Mayo Rey (Nord), Diamaré (Extrême-Nord), and Bénoué (Nord), with production levels estimated at 163,994 MT, 151,621 MT, 143,782 MT, 140,610 MT, and 138,513 MT. In contrast, lower production values are observed in Lebialem (Sud-Ouest), Hauts Plateaux (Ouest), Mifi (Ouest), Mfoundi (Centre), and Koung Khi (Ouest) with production of 147 MT, 117 MT, 116 MT, 105 MT, and 99 MT, respectively.

Compared to 2024, the most significant sorghum production increases in 2025 are expected in districts such as Mayo Rey (Nord), Logone et Chari (Extrême-Nord), Boumba et Ngoko (Est), Mayo Danay (Extrême-Nord), and Mayo Tsanaga (Extrême-Nord), with
